



ARTERIAL STUDY

Blood pressure is measured in the legs to detect a possible arterial blockage. If the pressures are normal, an ultrasound exam will be performed to look at the arteries and determine how severe the blockage is. The patient lies on a table while the study is performed, and the exam requires no I.V. or work on the part of the patient.

Main uses: If a patient complains of leg discomfort while walking. In more severe cases, the discomfort occurs even at rest.
